Out of concern and caution for the safety of our students, the school **Board of Trustees have decided to ban the use of e-scooters, e-skateboards and segways, effective from the start of next term.** 

This decision has been made in order to prevent the potential of serious accidents from happening in an already congested area of traffic for our students. We know that students who use these modes of transportation will be disappointed, but keeping students at our school safe is the most important thing to consider.

Students are welcome to use non-motorised scooters or bikes to get to and from school providing they are wearing appropriate safety helmets. We thank you for your understanding and support.

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
