

AUCKLAND ART GALLERY TOI O TAMAKI

This year, as a part of our MindPlus program, we got to go to the Auckland Art Gallery.

One group started in the workshop where we made collages that represented our whenua Rangitoto. We tore out pages from newspapers, one page each for a picture that represents yourself, family, distant family and a place that has a connection with you. Using a small card we cut and glued on the pieces to create a collage of Rangitoto that also represented ourselves and our families.

Afterwards, the two groups rotated, one went to the workshop and the other went around the gallery. At the gallery, we saw historical portraits and abstract art and learnt about their style of

painting, realism and abstract. We drew and copied the portraits for realism and stuck facial features on a plastic face that created our own Picasso style of painting.

Finally, we met back in the centre and headed back to school. We had so much fun and learned so many new things about art. WHOOPING COUGH

Whooping cough (pertussis) is a highly infectious disease and causes breathing difficulties and severe coughing fits. It can be very serious for tamariki and young babies.



It can easily spread between

family members by coughing and sneezing. It can also spread quickly around early education centres and schools, which is why it is important to make sure your whānau are up-to-date with vaccinations.

Whooping cough vaccines are free for pregnant people, all children under 18 years old and adults from 45 and 65 years old.

The Boostrix vaccine also offers protection against tetanus and diphtheria.
